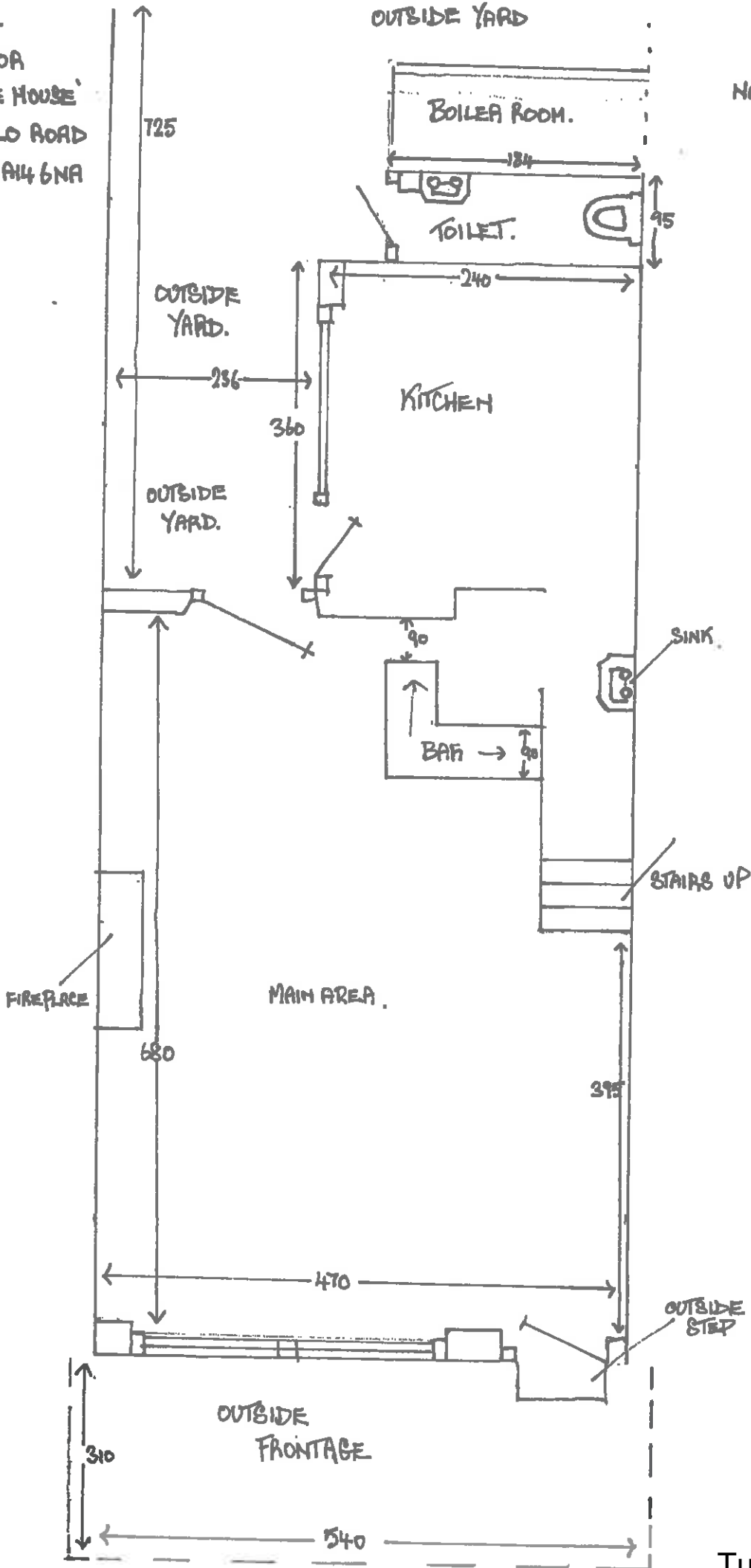



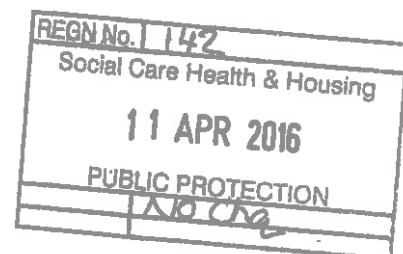

I write regarding the above and its proposed opening as a Microbar. I live directly next door to this property and I strongly object against this application for the following reasons;

1. There is already insufficient public parking in the area and this property has none, although there are parking bays on the highway opposite which are being reduced by half re: waiting restriction and street parking places order 2015 Llandeilo Road, Cross Hands A476. This reduction would limit the parking approximately 2-3 cars, causing further congestion and traffic offences by visitors.
2. The noise and disturbance of another licensed premises within the residential area would increase and cause concerns to neighbouring properties. There is already a Workingmen's Club and a public house located within 50 yards of the property which often causes disturbance on Llandeilo Road. By allowing another licensed property to open would increase noise levels & disturbance to the residence of Llandeilo Road. Furthermore my house is directly attached to No 21 the noise levels dramatically increase and would travel through my house exceeding acceptable levels. An increase in noise levels in the evenings would affect my life and sleep.
3. When the property was initially granted an alcohol licence, the smoking ban in public places was not enforced. The property has a limited back yard area which I understand will be a dedicated area for smokers. This area is separated by a boundary wall / fence and the proposed access to the smoking area would be via an rear door of the property which is within 1 metre of my back door and kitchen/living area. The constant use of this door would increase noise levels and will become a nuisance. My grandchildren also play within this area which is adjacent to the smoking area. Due to the close proximity of the rear properties I do not welcome the thought of my grandchildren, family members or any visitors being subjected to excessive



**noise, bad language and passive smoking emerging from the smoking area.**

4. **Within the smoking area is situated a LPG gas tank which is clearly labelled that there should be no smoking or naked flames nearby. Allowing the smoking area within the proximity of the tank is a great concern as the risk of an explosion is high.**

I am writing to you regarding a planning application that has be made for a business that plans to serve alcohol in a property at 21 Llandeilo Rd Cross Hands.

I would like to have my objections noted based on my concerns stated below.

- The first item would be a parking issue for intended customers, there is no designated parking for this property, and as of a notice placed on Llandeilo rd, there is a planning request to remove 3 parking spaces opposite this site, which if passed would only add to an already difficult parking issue for existing traders.
- Where would the smoking customers congregate? There is a small garden at the back with an existing old toilet, next to an LPG tank with states no naked flames, and another LPG Tank in my property feeding my heating requirement?
- Being next door the thought of individuals standing (or sitting) outside the shop, would cause a disturbance to other individuals walking and possibly affecting mine and other businesses in the area.
- We already have existing licensed properties in the area which serve the community and provide adequate parking and amenities.
- The amount of rubbish that will increase on the street.
- Inadequate toilets could lead to individuals looking at other areas to avoid waiting.
- This street is predominately residential and the affects on individuals and families with groups of people cramming into what is essentially a 2 bedroom property, inside and outside late into the evening could degenerate into a very unhappy environment.
