Discussion Topic	Background
Fair and Safe Communities group Annual Report 2016/17	One of the key roles of the Environmental & Public Protection Scrutiny Committee in its capacity as the Council's Crime & Disorder Scrutiny Committee is to scrutinise the work of the County's Community Safety Partnership.
