# **CCC Event Support Fund Applications May 2018**

#### BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT.

As part of a series of actions to grow the contribution of events and festivals in Carmarthenshire, £20,000.00 has been approved to provide an event support fund scheme aimed at providing financial assistance to events in the county that can demonstrate that they can make a contribution to the Tourism, Community and Economic strategic aims. As of 1st May 2018, £4,500 has already been committed from the 18/19 fund whilst the following applications have been received and assessed against the criteria with recommendations listed below:
