Local Authority Education Services Self Evaluation	The Local Authority supports the progression and impact of its services through a range of ongoing evaluation strategies. A key part of this work is the drawing together of our provision and performance via this 'commentary document' set in the context of the revised Estyn Inspection Framework for LAs.	To provide members with the opportunity to contribute to the development of the document through consideration of its content at this point.
Healthy Schools Initiative	This item will provide an opportunity for members to comment upon the Healthy Schools Initiative.	To enable members to exercise their scrutiny role.
