Councillor Lloyd would have a personal interest in any council business relating to or likely to affect the Heart of Wales Line by virtue of paragraph (10)(2)(ee) of the members code as the organisation is a private association in which Councillor Lloyd is a member.

This interest would be prejudicial as a member of the public with knowledge of the relevant facts would reasonably regard the interest as so significant that it is likely to prejudice his judgement of the public interest.

The application is made on 1 ground specified in the regulations, namely that his participation would not damage public confidence in the conduct of that Council business.
