## **APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE MID AND WEST WALES FIRE AND RESCUE AUTHORITY**

**REVIEW FOLLOWING COUNCILLOR R. EVANS' RESIGNATION FROM THE INDEPENDENT GROUP AND NOTIFICATION OF WISH TO JOIN THE LABOUR GROUP**

The Chief Executive received notice from Councillor R. Evans on the 30<sup>th</sup> January that he had resigned from the Independent Group on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2019 and had joined the Labour Group with effect from that date. Having reviewed the political balance of the authority, the Plaid Cymru Group will need to relinquish a seat on the Mid and West Wales Fire & Rescue Authority to the Labour Group.

Following discussions with Group Leaders, the Plaid Cymru Group has relinquished the seat held by Councillor Mansel Charles and the Labour Group have nominated Councillor Rob Evans to take this seat.

There are no changes required to any other outside bodies/Council advisory Panels.
