**FEEDBACK FROM THE CEREDIGION RURAL CRIME MEETING**

The Panel has identified Rural Crime as one of the key themes that it wishes to focus on.

Panel member Cllr. Lloyd Edwards organised a meeting in Aberaeron during May at which Panel Members, the Commissioner, Chief Constable, Senior Police Officers and Ben Lake MP were in attendance before a public audience and the local press.

The meeting was chaired by Cllr. Alun Lloyd-Jones

A range of issues relating to rural crime were discussed, including;

1. The Commissioner's Rural Crime Strategy
2. The Rural Crime Team that has been established by the force
3. Co-operation with North Wales Police
4. Under reporting of rural crime
5. Burglary
6. Theft of quadbikes and other machinery
7. Livestock thefts
8. Illegal occupation of land
9. The worrying of livestock by dogs
