#### **SUBJECT**

### SUSPENSION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE HC 415 REGISTRATION NUMBER AK60 GWL

Mr Anthony John Wathan of Towy Taxi's, 22 Towy Avenue, Llandovery was found to be operating Hackney Carriage Vehicle HC 415 Registration Number AK60 GWL in breach of the Councils Conditions of Licence for Hackney Carriage Vehicles. These breaches were found on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2018, 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 and 16<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

The Councils Conditions of Licence state that "If during one or more spot check of the vehicle a total of 3 non-mechanical breaches of condition are identified within an 18 month period, the Authority shall in accordance with Section 60(1) (c) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 treat the matter as reasonable cause for suspension of the vehicle licence. The suspension will remain in force for a minimum period of 14 days. Vehicles which fail to comply with the conditions after 14 days will not have the suspension lifted until such a time as compliance is achieved".
