EXECUTIVE SUMMARY STANDARDS COMMITTEE 26TH SEPTEMBER 2019

APPLICATION FOR DISPENSATION BY COUNCILLOR ROBERT JAMES

An application has been received from County Councillor Robert James for dispensation to speak and vote in respect of a Motion on Notice to be considered by Full Council on the 9th October 2019 regarding the Dyfed Pension Fund.

All County Councillors are members of the pension fund and therefore would have a personal interest in the motion on notice. However that interest would NOT be prejudicial by virtue of paragraph 12(2)(b)(iv) of the Code.

Councillor James would also have a personal interest in the motion on notice by virtue of paragraph 10(2) (b)(i) of the code as his partner (a close personal associate) is also a member of the pension fund.

This personal interest would also be prejudicial as a member of the public with knowledge of the relevant facts would reasonably regard the interest as so significant that it would be likely to prejudice the Councillor's judgement of the public interest.

Councillor James has submitted his application on the basis of three grounds set out in the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations)(Wales) regulations 2011 (as amended) namely:

- 1. That at least half the members considering the business has an interest
- 2. That the interest is common to me and a significant proportion of the general public.

Whilst it is correct that over half of the members of the Council are members of the pension fund and therefore have an interest in the motion, it is difficult to say to what extent other members also have an interest under paragraph 10(2)(b)(i).

According to the Pension Fund website, on the 31st March 2016 the Fund has 44,931 members across local government, the police and fire service.

In addition to the above, the committee may also wish to consider whether the ground under regulation 2(d) of the 2011 regulations apply, namely that the nature of Cllr James's interest is such that his participation in the debate and vote would not damage public confidence in the conduct of the relevant authority's business.

If the committee is minded to grant Councillor James a dispensation in respect of this interest it has absolute discretion as to the duration of that dispensation.
