Highways Update

This report provides the Committee with an update on the highway service reviews undertaken to date, outlining preliminary proposals to amend levels of service so as to address the reduced budget available to the service for the next three years.

The length of highway network maintained in Carmarthenshire at 3343km or 2085 miles, is the second largest in Wales, and is more than double the Welsh average of 1566km. It also has the second largest length of Class 1 roads in Wales second only to Gwynedd. The highway asset consists of some 16 million square metres of carriageway.
