## SUBJECT Review of Hackney Carriage Maximum Table of Fares

As a result of the increasing overheads incurred by the Taxi trade, an application has been received to increase the current maximum table of fares.

The following proposal is presented for consideration: -

#### **CURRENT HACKNEY CARRIAGE MAXIMUM TABLE OF FARES**

Initial Charge	£2.20	£2.40	£2.40
Additional mileage for each one tenth of a mile or part thereof	£0.20	£0.25	£0.30
Waiting time (per minute)	£0.20	£0.25	£0.30

A Tariff 2 surcharge on the meter shall apply on Sundays, Public and Bank Holidays and nightly after 10.00 pm until 3.00 am.

A Tariff 3 surcharge on the meter shall apply from 3.00am until 6.00am
