BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT

A full membership review took place and nominations formally approved in May 2023. It was acknowledged that an additional nomination for a Community representative be re-advertised. A further exercise to recruit an additional Community representation was undertaken in May 2023 via "One Voice Wales which resulted in a single nomination.

An exercise to seek nominations from all Carmarthenshire Secondary Heads was delayed until the start of the new Academic year in September 2023 to ensure all new Heads in post.
