Environmental & Public Protection Scrutiny Committee task and finish review of Substance Misuse Treatment Services

Action Plan Monitoring

Review Background

The Environmental & Public Protection Scrutiny Committee has a key role to play in monitoring services, development of key policies and strategies, as well as identifying areas for improvement or development. At its meeting on 27th February 2013, the Committee received a report on Commissioning of Substance Misuse Services in Carmarthenshire. Following consideration of this report, it unanimously resolved to undertake a task and finish review in relation to value for money in substance misuse services commissioned in the county.

Objectives and Scope

Following its first meeting, the Group's agreed that its main objective for the review would be to:

- Consider value for money and effectiveness of adult drug and alcohol treatment services and review work undertaken to prevent drug and alcohol abuse in the Carmarthenshire

Approach

A total of 6 meetings were held between June 2013 and January 2014 during which the Group considered evidence and information from a wide variety of sources and organisations. Each session was designed to provide the Group with the relevant information, context and background to the topic.

The Task and Finish Group consisted of Councillors Ivor Jackson (Chair), Ryan Bartlett, Daff Davies, Winston Lemon, Alan Speake, Bill Thomas, Emlyn Dole (Co-opted Member)

Following the commencement of the review, the Group received a request from the Social Care & Health Scrutiny Committee (from its meeting on the 21st June 2013) that Cllr. Emlyn Dole, as Chair of that Committee, be co-opted onto the Group. The Social Care & Health Scrutiny Committee suggested that this would ensure a health perspective on any issues discussed during the review. The Task & Finish Group approved the request prior to its second meeting on the 5th July 2013.

The Scrutiny & Consultancy Team provided research and general support to the Group. In addition, officers from the Chief Executive's and Social Care & Health Departments and the Hywel Dda Health Board provided specialist advice and support to the Group.

Final Report and Recommendations

The Environmental & Public Protection Scrutiny Committee received and endorsed the Group's final report and the recommendations at its meeting on the 24th February 2014. The report was duly endorsed by the Executive Board at its meeting on the 31st March 2014.

Following every task and finish review, an action plan is developed in order to assist members of the relevant scrutiny committee in monitoring progress in relation to the implementation of the recommendations.

The attached implementation plan has been completed by the relevant officers in order to provide an update on progress to date in relation to this review.
