<b>Project Description</b>	<p>This grant application is to support a capital expenditure project incorporating the redevelopment of an old kitchen space into accessible multipurpose rooms, which will be utilised by a number of groups for activities and events.</p> <p>The hall is currently supported by community groups and hosts regular events including a weekly bowls club, a monthly market, Women’s Institute, Autumn craft fair, Spring plant sales, a lantern festival and a weekly foot clinic.</p> <p>The refurbishment to the hall will include making good the walls, replacing single glazed windows and exterior door, replacing flooring, insulation of walls, re-plastering and upgrading lighting and heating.</p> <p>This will enable the facility to provide additional services, such as educational workshops, IT training, Language and music skills, Welsh Language conversational skills and any other services or activities required by the community.</p> <p>Currently it is too costly to run too many services from the main hall, particularly during the winter months, so having the use of an easy to heat room, would enable services and new activities to be undertaken all year round.</p>

<b>Project Description</b>	<p>Llanybydder is a rural market town with a population of about 1,700 with three quarters being Welsh speaking. The activities undertaken at the Chapel are conducted through the medium of the Welsh language, though bilingual events are arranged if requested.</p> <p>At this present time the Chapel currently have 93 members and 40 members attend regularly for Sunday services, organisations who regularly utilise the facility for activities and events are;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Women's Institute</li> <li>• Merched y Wawr</li> <li>• Cor Lleisiau'r Werin</li> <li>• Llanybydder Community Council</li> <li>• Old People's Welfare Committee</li> <li>• Diabetic Group</li> <li>• Carmarthenshire County Council Housing Department</li> </ul> <p>The chapel also supports the local care home and primary school which has around 10% of its pupils from ethnic minority backgrounds, whose parents are employed at the large abattoir. The building is important to the community not only as a place of worship but also as a community centre for integrating and socialising.</p> <p>To ensure the facility is in good repair and remains fit for purpose for the current and future members and users, essential refurbishment works are required, which will include replacing, existing wooden windows, doors, soffits, fascia boards, guttering and down pipes.</p> <p>The windows are believed to be over 100 years old and have been painted and repaired regularly over many years but have now deteriorated so badly, have to be replaced with UPVC.</p>

<b>Applicant</b>	<b>St Mary's Church, Court Henry</b>
<b>Project Description</b>	<p>St Mary's Church, Court Henry is situated close to the village of Dryslwyn and is one of five parish churches within the community of Llangathen.</p> <p>The church is well used in the community, not only for normal Sunday service, and the annual church calendar celebrations – Easter, Harvest and Christmas, but also for regular meetings of the Mother's Union, and continual usage by the primary school e.g. Christmas and St David's Day concerts.</p> <p>This additional usage is of huge benefit to community life as it is not only an opportunity for social interaction, but also attracts non regular church members through the church doors and the donations contribute to the future sustainability of the venue. Additionally the church is used for weddings, christenings and funerals. The church is available to other organisations to use/hire.</p> <p>Recent inspection identified essential works needed to the church roof – ingress of rainwater due to perished lead valleys which are allowing water to penetrate the ceiling of the church, which if not addressed, would escalate to a detrimental and costly state of disrepair. Inspection by an architect and a conservation and repair specialist agreed the works to be carried out as detailed in project costs below.</p> <p>It is imperative that the church be kept in a good state of repair, not only for the preservation of the building for future generations to enjoy, but also to provide a safe and comfortable environment for current usage and congregation but also to attract additional users and services for the long term future sustainability.</p>
