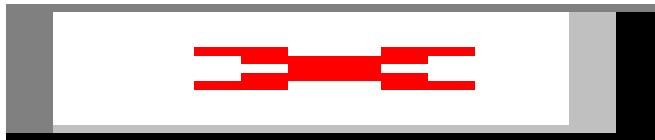

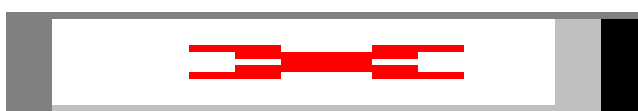

- The applicant is seeking to provide Regulated Entertainment in an external area from 18:00 to 22:30
- Number of TENs applied for over a short duration
- The nature and character of the locality
- The external area of the above premises area is in proximity to domestic properties.
- Noise Apps recordings submitted by complainants on the 2nd of July 2022 contained noise from



amplified music clearly audible from inside the complainants properties.

- Noise monitoring undertaken at complainants property contains evidence of noise from amplified music and also from people noise.
- Noise complaints have been received in relation to loud music being played at the above premises and also from people noise.
