DISPENSATION APPLICATION BY COUNCILLOR A DAVIES

A dispensation application has been received from Councillor Ann Davies of Carmarthenshire County Council . Councillor Davies is a Cabinet Member.

Councillor Davies seeks dispensation to speak and make written representations to the Council's Advisory Panels that are undertaking a review of the Council's rural estate.

Councillor Davies has a personal interest in those reviews as her husband is a tenant on a Council farm which they have occupied since 1991

A reasonable member of the public with knowledge of these facts would be likely to conclude that this would influence the Councillor's view of the wider public interest when it came to that review.

The application from Councillor Davies is attached to this report. The grounds upon which a dispensation can be granted are set out in the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations)(Wales) Regulations 2001 . The ground relied upon by Cllr Davies is that her participation is justified by her particular role and expertise. (Regulation 2(f))

In addition, the committee may feel that the further ground that her participation would not damage public confidence (Regulation 2(d)) is also relevant.

If the committee is minded to grant Councillor Davies a dispensation it will need to determine its duration.

**DISPENSATION APPLICATION BY COUNCILLOR P H
THOMAS**

A dispensation application has been received from Councillor P H Thomas of St. Ishmael's Council .

Councillor Thomas seeks dispensation to speak and vote in relation to council business regarding the foreshore and cockling activities in the Three Rivers estuary.

Councillor Thomas has a personal interest in council business relating to such matters as he works in the cockling industry.

A reasonable member of the public with knowledge of these facts would be likely to conclude that this would influence the Councillor's view of the wider public interest when it came to Council decisions on the issue.

The Council has no decision making role in relation to the use of the foreshore or the permitting of cockling activities. The Council does not own any land affected by those activities however these activities are the subject of frequent discussion at council meetings.

The application from Councillor Thomas is attached to this report. The grounds upon which a dispensation can be granted are set out in the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations)(Wales) Regulations 2001 . Those relied upon by Cllr Thomas are

1. That his inability to participate would upset the political balance of the council to such an extent that the outcome would be likely to be affected. (Regulation 2(c)). This ground only applies to County and County Borough Councils
2. His participation would not damage public confidence (Regulation 2(d))
3. His participation is justified by his particular role and expertise. (Regulation 2(f))

If the committee is minded to grant Councillor Thomas a dispensation it will need to determine its duration.


