Electricity transmission from Nant Mithil Energy Park, Forrest of Radnor and potentially other energy park developments to grid connection in Carmarthenshire.

What is your interest in the above matter? I am a landowner. I received the introductory letter but as of 31.1.23, there has been no request for access onto my land to undertake survey work, though that might change. I have immediate neighbours and close associates who have received requests for access onto land to undertake survey work. Should pylons be erected, it is possible that they would be visible from my property. Should pylons be erected, there would be potential impact on the value of my property. I am the current Chairman of Llanarthne Community council, and likely to remain a member of the council's standing subcommittee (chair, vice chair and immediate past chair) called upon to discuss issues that require a swift response/to make representations to the community council. The community council will inevitably need to engage with the currently informal 'response group', and I have been mentioned in that group's meeting notes. I am the current county vice chairman of NFU Cymru, albeit in a personal capacity as opposed to my councillor role. The nature of the matter will inevitably require the union to address the issue. It is likely that I will be called upon to be present in meetings where the issue will be discussed. When will the above matter be considered? It is likely that the matter will be discussed periodically over the forthcoming three or four years. The Standards committee has already granted me a dispensation to speak and to make written representations at meetings of Carmarthenshire County Council in respect of any Council business relating to farming and farming related matters generally, from 13th June 2022 until the end of the current electoral term. However, the Committee advised me to seek further legal advice and, if necessary, apply for another dispensation in the event that I wished to participate in council business which specifically related to, or was likely to affect, my or close personal associates' farming activities or farmland. I am therefore making a specific application for a dispensation to participate on matters relating to the proposal for an energy transmission scheme in part of the Tywi Valley, which may involve the erection of pylons and overhead electricity cables. It is not yet clear whether any of the scheme will directly impact my own land, or whether it will just be visible from my land, but I have received a notification from the proposed developer.

As a county councillor, I have received calls about the issue and I have been copied into correspondence by ward residents sent to the company/companies requesting access onto land. The issue, however, will impact on several wards. It is not exclusive to the ward that I represent, either as a County Councillor or a Community Councillor. The energy transmission scheme in question will impact on landowners and/or tenants (private and local authority) who use land for various purposes, including agricultural. I feel that I have an understanding of the practical effects and consequences of such a development (buried cables or above ground infrastructure) on land-based enterprises, and therefore would be able to offer a valuable insight as part of any discussion.

It is difficult to say what types of debates might arise in meetings at Council, Committees or Panels on the matter, but for example I am aware that on a previous proposal elsewhere in the County a Motion on Notice was tabled for debate at County Council about the proposed lines being overground and not underground, so there is a potential for debates about the proposal to arise.

I should note that I serve on the rural affairs and climate change advisory panels where the matter is likely to be
discussed, as well as at full council.
