SUBJECT

PROPOSED TRANSFER OF COUNTY COUNCIL LAND TO THE OWNERSHIP OF THE DIOCESAN OF MENEVIA AT ST JOHN LLOYD V.A. SCHOOL, LLANELLI.

1. BRIEF SUMMARY OF PURPOSE OF REPORT.

Background

In April 1989 the former St John Lloyd school building which was constructed on Diocese Land was demolished following an intense fire which left the school building in total ruin. In order to get the school fully operational as soon as possible, mobile classrooms were brought into the site as a temporary measure whilst a new school building was constructed on CCC Land. The school and Diocese have received support from CCC in resolving issues relating to the lack of land for playing fields and for construction. They have also been working to resolve other historical issues relating to the ownership of further parts of land on the site

St John Lloyd RC School, Llanelli is the only faith based secondary school covering the geographical area west of Swansea. The School is currently over subscribed in all year groups and has been for the last 10-12 years. The school capacity is currently 465 but the current number on roll is in excess of 500.

On the 20th June 2016 the CCC Executive Board approved the revised MEP 21st Century schools Programme which included the scheme at St John Lloyd RC School in Llanelli.

On the 8th June 2016 a Business Case was submitted to Welsh Government seeking approval to invest £3.2m to build a new science block, an extension onto the existing sportshall and a major refurbishment of the existing classrooms within the main block.

On the 8th August 2016 Welsh Government approved £3.2m for this scheme

As part of the WG Grant conditions (School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013, Part 3 – Transfer of Land, The following conditions apply where:

a) Land is transferred to and vests in a body in accordance with the schedule (i.e the construction of a new building must take place on Diocese land).

Proposal

In order that the construction of the new Science block and Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) can take place at St John Lloyd school the authority needs to arrange the transfer of CCC Land over to the ownership of the Diocesan of Menevia.

The Diocese will not be required to make any payment for the land and that the County Council and the Diocese will meet their own costs in the transaction.

Conclusion

Executive Board Member for ECS and the Executive Board Member for Resources have the opportunity to agree to the proposed transfer or not.

The process outlined above would enable the Authority's legal team to complete the transfer in order that the construction programme can legally take place.

The proposed scheme at St John Lloyd school, Llanelli will sustain future pupil demand and for the long term will be suitable in size to accommodate the anticipated increases in pupil population by 2026, safeguarding secondary faith based provision in Carmarthenshire.

Recommendation

Executive Board Member for ECS and the Executive Board Member for Resources are requested to approve the proposal to transfer the required land at St John Lloyd to the Diocesan ownership.
