Officers of the County Council describe this as one of the most complicated issues they have dealt with. ref: Jonathan Morgan. I have taken an informal role of lead of the sewerage group working with all parties, including Carmarthenshire Council to enable a solution. After six years, and covid delays, it has been narrowed down to a couple of technical options which none of the parties can afford due to age, limited or nil property equity, inability to sell due to the issue. The Millennium Community Hall is currently operating with portaloos and no kitchen facility. This limits income especially post covid and is untenable. Sewerage discharge is affecting the community, private homes and wellbeing.

The Community Council are now to step in and consider what sort of facilitation can finally resolve the issue for all parties the and essential village amenities. Given my role and the level of research undertaken along with the personal contact with all parties I request dispensation to speak and answer any questions from community councillors. In the event the meeting would not be otherwise quorate then I would also request to vote as the circumstances are of an exceptional nature.
