# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER DECISION MEETING FOR TECHNICAL SERVICES 4<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2017

## **LLANELLI SHOPMOBILITY**

The County Council has supported the Llanelli Shopmobility scheme since 2011. The current funding arrangement is due to expire this year.

The Llanelli scheme provides a valuable service for the disabled and has been successful with 232 members to date.

The group generates income from charges and fund raising. The scheme is however mainly reliant on the County Council's financial support. The Group has requested further financial support from the Council for the current year, amounting to £ 14,000.

Shopmobility is one of many initiatives being encouraged by the Authority to support the town and is one of the key priorities within our Integrated Parking Strategy i.e.

"To provide more facilities for the mobility impaired" – including appropriate levels of parking provision within car parks and through the encouragement of Shop Mobility schemes within town centres."

The Council has set aside funding to fund a further twelve months support.

It is therefore recommended that the Llanelli Shopmobilty scheme be supported for a further twelve months.

#### Recommendation.

The Llanelli Shopmobility be supported with a further grant of £14,000 for the 2017/18 financial year.
