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# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## SUBJECT

### Application for Dispensation by Newcastle Emlyn Town Councillor Hazel Evans

An application for dispensation has been received from Newcastle Emlyn Town Councillor Hazel Evans.

The application relates to Town Council business regarding the grant of tenancy of the Old Courthouse where there are two applicants, and Town Cllr. Evans is a non-remunerated Director of one of the applicants, which itself is a charity. This constitutes a personal and prejudicial interest under the Code of Conduct.

Cllr. Evans seeks a dispensation to Speak and Vote and to make written recommendations on the following grounds in the Standards Committees (Grant of Dispensations)(Wales) Regulations 2001.

1. Regulation 2(d) – the nature of the member's interest is such that their participating in the business to which the interest relates would not damage public confidence.
2. Regulation 2(f) – the participation of the member in the business to which the interest relates is justified by the member's particular role or expertise.

If the Committee is minded to grant the dispensation, its duration will also need to be considered.
