EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

GOVERNANCE AND AUDIT COMMITTEE 12TH JULY 2024

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS 2023/24

The Statement of Accounts for 2023/24 brings together all the financial transactions of the Authority for the year, and also details the Authority's assets and liabilities as at the 31st March 2024.

Overall the Authority's Council Fund net expenditure for the year was above the original budget for 2023/24, and you will note the following results are reported in the Movement in Reserves Statement:

Council Fund (Generally available for new expenditure), transfer from balances £755k.
Balances held by schools under local management schemes, transfer from balances £5.9m.
Housing Revenue Account, decrease in balance of £5m.

In the preparation of these accounts there have been movements to and from earmarked reserves. In particular transfers to:

Major Development Fund: Transfer of £4.672m to support major developments in the future.

MEP Capital Funding: £2.573m set aside in the 2023/24 budget to meet the cost of prudential borrowing to finance the Modernising Education Provision programme.

The City Deal / Pentre Awel Reserve: Transfer £1.857m to meet potential future expenditure/liabilities in respect of the development of Carmarthenshire County Council City Deal projects.

Members are therefore asked to retrospectively approve these movements.

Overall the Authority's Council Fund net expenditure for the year was above the original budget, resulting in a transfer of £755k from balances on the Council Fund and a transfer of £5m from the Housing Revenue Account balance.

At the balance sheet date, the Council Fund General Balances stood at £14.001m, the Housing Revenue Account £11.996m and the balances held by schools under LMS £5.175m.

The reserves created and included within the Statement of Accounts have been set up to meet future liabilities.
