I refer to the above Licensing + Planning consultations, and based on the application details provided, I have the following comments to make with respect to noise.

Based on the information submitted to date, I am unable to determine the likely impact of noise on nearby dwellings. In order that potential noise impacts can be taken into consideration, I would request a written noise impact assessment (NIA) and noise mitigation plan (NMP) for the development, submitted by the applicant. The noise assessment and management plan should have regard to the operation of the development, hours of operation and any other significant operational or potential mechanical noise sources associated with the development. Failure to submit a written noise impact assessment and noise mitigation plan for the development and allowing for the Planning Authority to consider any likely noise impacts will result in the Pollution Section raising an objection to the proposed development.
