**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

**Appointment of a new Co-opted Independent member of the Standards Committee**

Article 9 of the Council's Constitution provides that the Standards Committee has a total membership of 9 members, 5 of whom are co-opted independent members.

One of the co-opted members left the committee earlier in 2024.

In accordance with recruitment procedures prescribed by regulations, a recruitment panel was formed consisting of three County Councillors, one Town/Community Councillor and one lay member. The vacancy was advertised in local papers and online and following interviews the recruitment panel selected a Mr. David Morgan as their recommended candidate.

Mr. Morgan is a former police officer who has the required skills and experience to undertake the role.

Full Council is therefore requested to appoint Mr. Morgan as a co-opted independent member of the Standards Committee for a full initial term of office.
