STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS 2023/24

In line with the Accounts and Audit (Wales) Regulations 2014 (as amended 2018), the Statement of Accounts is now presented to Audit Committee for approval.

Overall the Authority's Council Fund net expenditure for the year was above the original budget, resulting in a transfer of £755k from balances on the Council Fund and a transfer of £5.002m from the Housing Revenue Account balance.

At the balance sheet date, the Council Fund General Balances stood at £14.001m, the Housing Revenue Account £11.996m and the balances held by schools under LMS £5.175m.
