Y Pwrpas: I ystyried Rhybudd Gynnig a gyfeiriwyd at y Cabinet gan y Cyngor Sir ar 11 o Fedi 2024

Penderfyniadau allweddol sydd eu hangen: Trafodaethau er mwyn symud y Rhybudd Gynnig yn ei flaen.

Mae Masnach Deg yn fudiad byd-eang sy'n ceisio sicrhau bod cynhyrchwyr mewn gwledydd sy'n datblygu yn cael pris teg am eu nwyddau, yn gweithio o dan amodau diogel, ac yn arddel arferion amgylcheddol gynaliadwy. NOTICE OF MOTION – FAIRTRADE

The Notice of Motion received at County Council -

“Fairtrade is a global movement that aims to ensure that producers in developing countries are paid a fair price for their goods, work under safe conditions, and engage in environmentally sustainable practices. By adhering to Fairtrade standards, farmers and workers can invest in their communities, improve their livelihoods, and build a more secure future. Fairtrade also empowers consumers to make ethical purchasing choices that support equitable trade relationships and contribute to the fight against global poverty and injustice.

This Council notes:

- The longstanding commitment of Carmarthenshire County Council to the Fairtrade campaign, which has been instrumental in promoting fair and ethical trading practices within our community.*
- The importance and success of Fairtrade towns within Carmarthenshire, including a vast amount of schools and places of worship, which have significantly contributed to raising awareness and support for Fairtrade principles among our residents.*

This Council resolves to:

- Reaffirm our commitment to supporting Fairtrade and the Fairtrade campaign within Carmarthenshire. **The Council will review its current arrangements and seek to reaffirm our commitment.***
- Recognise and celebrate the achievements of Fairtrade towns within our county, which have been pivotal in advocating for Fairtrade and ethical consumerism. **The Council will work with the community lead multi-agency Carmarthenshire Fair Trade Group (as noted below) and support promotion of good practice and achievements.***
- Support a Fairtrade Steering Committee, to oversee and coordinate Fairtrade activities and initiatives across Carmarthenshire. **A community lead multi-agency Fairtrade Committee for Carmarthenshire already exists and it is proposed that Cllr Aled Vaughan Owen (if agreed as the Fairtrade Champion) joins this group and ensures links into relevant Council services.***
- Appoint a Cabinet Member as a Champion for Fairtrade, who will actively promote and advocate for Fairtrade principles and initiatives within the Council and the wider community’. **The Leader of the Council seeks to appoint Cllr Aled Vaughan Owen as the Fairtrade Champion***
